SIAT Reynosa: Early Alert System: March 4
Migrants attempt to cross Mexico-US border in the vicinities of the International Bridge (Sector 2). As the team of writing the bridge requests proceed suggests that Customs and Border Protection authorities temporarily shut down the crossing of large numbers of migrants among illegally. On March 3-4 groups of migrant migrants gathering in the vicinity of the International Bridge (Sector 2). As the team of writing the bridge requests proceed suggests that Customs and Border Protection authorities temporarily shut down the crossing of large numbers of migrants among illegally. Such occurrences can lead to travel disruptions and longer checks through customs. Considering that there is high demand and surrounding the bridge, vehicular congestion at the border crossing point may occur.

SIAT LATAM: Early Alert System
Anticipate disruptions in Santiago on March 11 due to potential protests: Exercise heightened vigilance.

Current Situation:
The Social Unity Front (Frente de Unidad Social - FUS) left-leaning umbrella group is calling members and supporters to demonstrate against the government of conservative President Sebastián Piñera on March 11, two years after he came into office. On 11 various nationwide events are expected to take place at 11:00 (local time). Furthermore, at around 18:30 "marches" are expected to take place, especially in Santiago. Consideration are a form of popular protest consisting of people making noise by banging pots and pans to call for attention.

In view of heightened anti-government sentiment among leftist organizations, and increased localized unrest in Chilean cities, we advise security demonstration are likely to take place throughout Santiago and later evening hours in Santiago. Based on perimeter, focal points for protests include the extended city center, including the San Felipe area (outside the Metro station), the vicinity of the La Moneda Presidential Palace, Plaza O'Higgins Plaza, also known as Barón, and continue along O'Higgins Avenue, especially towards La Estación.
